

Old Business:

- The Beta Show Cause hearing has been rescheduled to 11/17.
- Cantina and Cabin are awaiting EXL inspection and potential hearing due to major modifications. There's a coalition forming to oppose the expansion of the Beta owner and to shut down Beta. A lobbying firm, The Pachner Company, has been engaged to help.
- We have engaged Texill, LLC (dba Sir) at 1822 Blake to develop a GNA
- We have engaged Whiskey Row Denver at 1946 Market St to develop a GNA

New Business:

- Old Chicago Taproom at 1735 19th St, Ste 150, is requesting a new Hotel and Restaurant liquor license, no cabaret license. The hearing is scheduled for 12/7 9am.
- Handsome Boys at 1403 Larimer St (Crimson Room) is requesting a transfer of ownership. Kyle is establishing a relationship with them.

Administrative activity:

- We reviewed the current GNA on 10/22 and created an updated template for future use with it being tested by Sir and Whiskey Row Denver
- The GNA tracking sheet has been updated with additional locations from historical data from Charles Nadler (Nadler folders in Green).
