

Old Business:

- The Beta Show Cause hearing was held on 11/17 and 11/18 and resulted in the permanent license revocation on 1/5. The Cantina (fka El Chapultepec) decision on the license transfer is coming soon and will likely be denied. The Cabin (fka Falling Rock Tap House) was sold to Tom Schaffer in early December. They have a Show Cause hearing scheduled for 1/18. They are under emergency shutdown due to the NYD shootings.
- Supported the cabaret licensing application from IDMM LoDo dba NoLa Jane at the public hearing on 1/10. The GNA has been completed and submitted to the City.
- Old Chicago Taproom at 1735 19th St, Ste 150, requested a new Hotel and Restaurant liquor license, no cabaret license. The hearing was unopposed on 12/7 and their license was approved.
- Viewhouse Corp at 2015 Market St is requested a premise modification. Matt Van Sistine from BallPark Collective took the lead and it was approved.
- Blake 1930 dba The Sports Column at 1930 Blake St has applied for a premise modification. The hearing was on 12/13 and was unopposed and approved. Mark Savit has established a relationship with Brad Manske who managed The Sports Column for Francois Saffiedine.

New Business:

- Specialty Restaurant Group dba Lost & Found at 1735 19th St, Unit C-100 is requesting a new Tavern and Standard Cabaret license. The hearing was continued to 2/8 at 9am.
